We have a pipe organ of beautifully crafted over 150 year old pipework and a grand piano donated by the van Kraayenoord family in 2013.

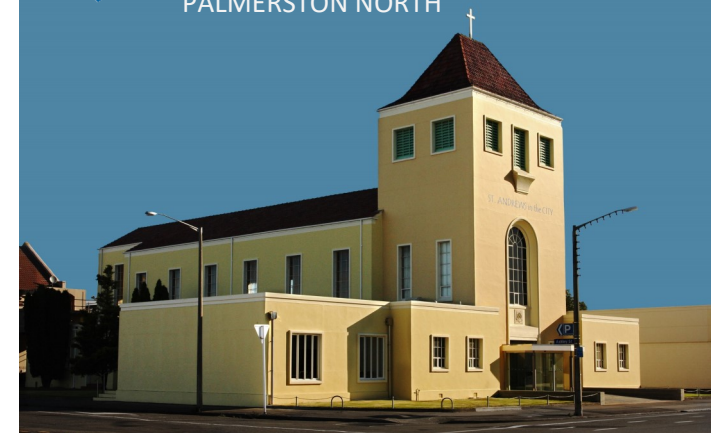
